The project brief is described as to provide accommodation for a projected long-term enrolment of 1,300 pupils + 2 Class SEN. A budget 24.8m has been allocated. Work has commenced on the establishment of a process for the procurement a Project Manager / design team. • In addition to this development, a feasibility Study has been completed and an application for the temporary accommodation classrooms has been submitted to the DES for consideration for the provision of 8 temporary accommodation classrooms to be in place for the new academic year to alleviate student overcrowding.
